

Illinois Masonic Scholarship Application:

- Grand Lodge of Illinois A.F. & A.M.
- Ancient Accepted Scottish Rite (AASR)

Illinois Grand Lodge and Scottish Rite Masons provide scholarships to help individuals better themselves through the pursuit of knowledge.

This application, official high school or college transcript, and letters of recommendation must be received by **March 1st** of the year in which the application is made. The aforementioned documents shall become the property of the Scottish Rite and of the Grand Lodge of A.F. & A.M. of Illinois.

The following application covers six scholarships. Each of which has unique qualifications. Select the one(s) being applied for. The completed application, official transcript(s) and letters of recommendation should be forwarded to the closest Scottish Rite Valley.

Scholarships Open to the Public

Health Career Fields: Masonic relationship is not required. The recipient must intend to enter the field of health care. Health care includes (but is not limited to) nursing, physical or occupational therapy, radiology, anesthesiology, etc.

Sherwood and Evelyn Kresin: Masonic relationship is not required. This scholarship has an exception for the “undergraduate only” restriction. The recipient may be in an undergraduate or a graduate course of study. There is no restriction regarding the recipient’s course of study.

Scholarships Requiring a Masonic Relationship

Grand Lodge of A.F. & A.M. of Illinois: Masonic relationship is required. The applicant must have a father or grandfather who is (or was at the time of his death) a member in good standing as an Illinois Master Mason. The applicant does not have to be a resident of Illinois.

Robert B. Perkins: Masonic relationship is required. The applicant must have a father, grandfather, brother, or uncle who is (or was, if deceased) a member in good standing of an Illinois Scottish Rite Valley. There is no restriction regarding the recipient’s course of study.

Louis L. Williams: Masonic relationship is required. The applicant must have a father, grandfather, brother, or uncle who is (or was, if deceased) a member in good standing of an Illinois Scottish Rite Valley. The applicant must attend Illinois Wesleyan University in Bloomington, Illinois. There is no restriction regarding the recipient’s course of study.

Leon M. Abbott: Named for Leon M. Abbott, Sovereign Grand Commander (1921-1932). The applicant must be a member of or directly related (bloodline or by legal means) to a Scottish Rite Mason in the Northern Masonic Jurisdiction. Also eligible are a members of youth organizations sponsored by the Masonic fraternity in the Northern Masonic Jurisdiction. The recipient must be either an undergraduate or graduate student attending an accredited college or university for the upcoming academic year. While all other scholarships require a B average, The Abbott has a minimum GPA of 2.75 on a 4.0 grade scale.

When the scholarship is granted, it may continue for as long as the recipient is enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student at an accredited college or university. However, it will be terminated at the end of the semester during which the recipient's cumulative grade point average is not a B or higher. It may also be terminated if the recipient changes institutions or his/her program without notification to the scholarship committee.

A scholarship recipient desiring to renew his/her scholarship for the ensuing year must forward to the scholarship chairman a letter of intent declaring his/her desire to continue as a scholarship recipient. This information must be submitted by March 1st and must be accompanied by the most recent transcript available.

Scholarship checks will be forwarded to the student's college or university to be credited to his/her account.

To be considered, the application must be **completed in full**.

You may submit only one application.

Your high school or college transcript is required. We prefer it to be bundled with the application, yet acknowledge some schools require mailing the transcripts separately.

Two letters of recommendation (one professional and one personal) must be submitted with your application packet. Both letters of recommendation must be written and placed in sealed envelopes. They are to be signed across the seal by the writer of the letter.

Forward this application, transcript, and your two letters of recommendation as a single bundle to the AASR Valley nearest you.
